Cllr Taylor attended and reported that he had a reply re road surfaces – school holidays, footways half moon Linton meadows, flooding issues have been considered

Finance data came out last week from government and it is not good as expected. Highlighted that rural communities need more finance, in particular more investment into roads, need to campaign for the money to come to the rural communities.

25-087 RAF Liaison Officers Report

Sqn Ldr Hicks reported that 'rumoured' news on MARSHALL (decommissioning of the radar) is not encouraging, with engineers and operators suggesting a further 'best guess' delay of 6 months.

In terms of work onsite: Severn Trent Services to finish off works around the main gate; BT replacing some old analogue to fibre optic lines; DIO/VIVO successfully completed a Station Standby Generator tests onload; Annington Homes are full steam ahead refurbishing properties and we understand they are looking to lease/rent out, not sell, the properties possibly late summer; idverde (Grounds Maintenance) are on site en masse this week to keep the weeds/grass in check etc and next week we have 5001 Sqn, RAF Wittering replacing a broken air conditioning unit that cools the radar tower.
